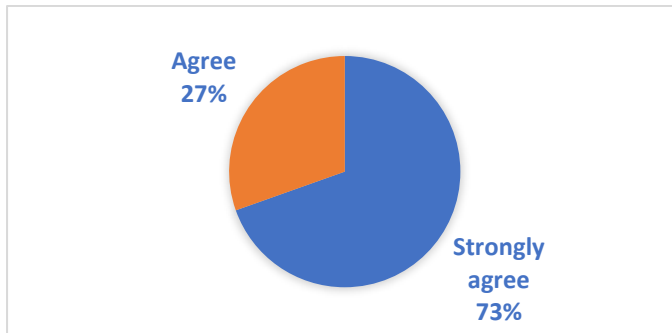

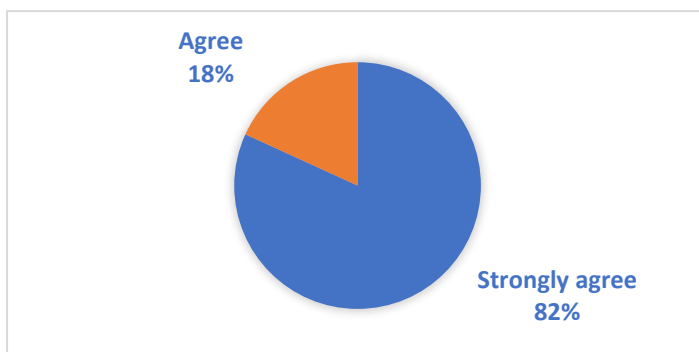
Q1. The school makes me aware of what my child is learning.

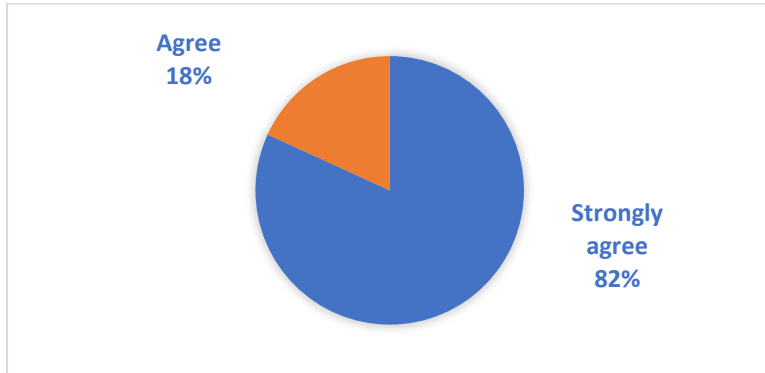
Q2. There is a good range of subjects and learning experiences available to my child at this school.

Q3. The curriculum newsletters and knowledge organisers are informative and helpful.

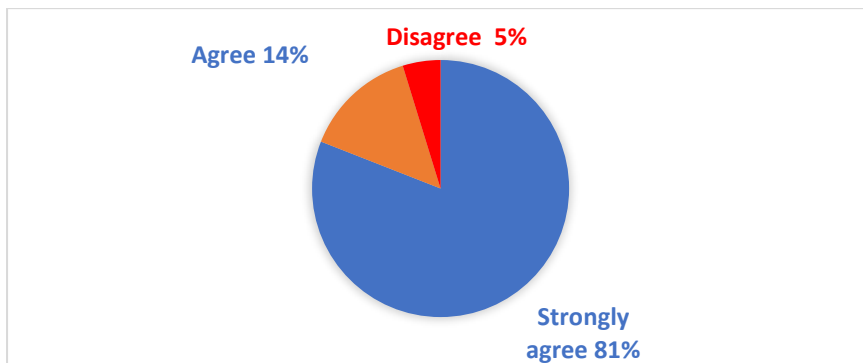

Q4. The school considers and caters for my child's individual learning need.

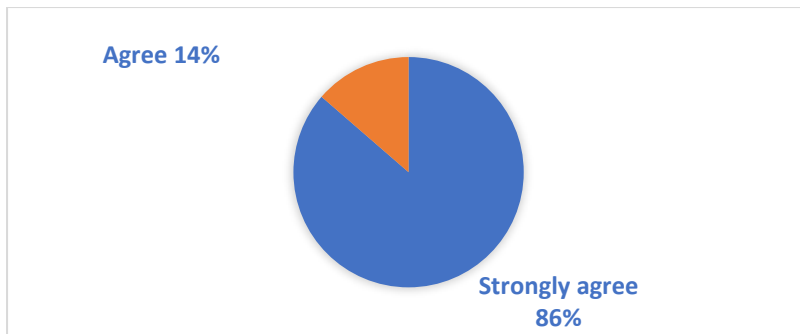

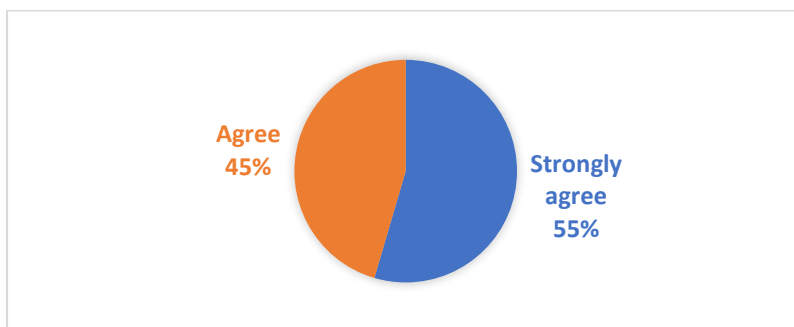
Q5. The school provides a wide range of enrichment activities through hook days, visitors and external visits.

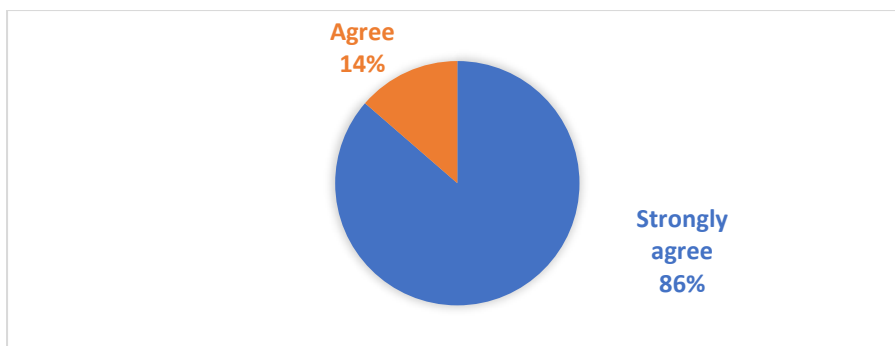
Q6. The school supports my child’s wider personal development through clubs, sporting events and the use of wider curriculum specialists.

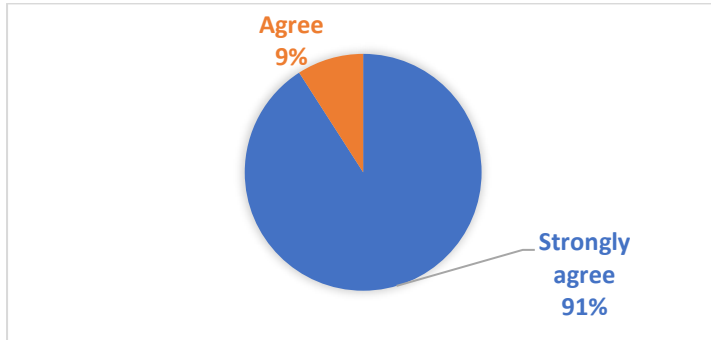
Q7. Parent meetings are informative about my child’s progress and attainment.

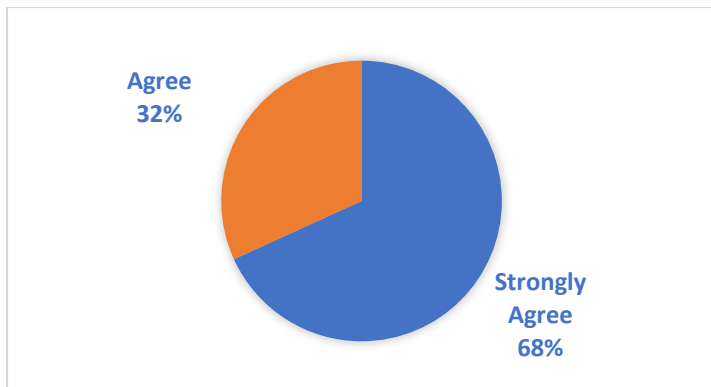
Q8. The school has high expectations for my child.
