## Pollution

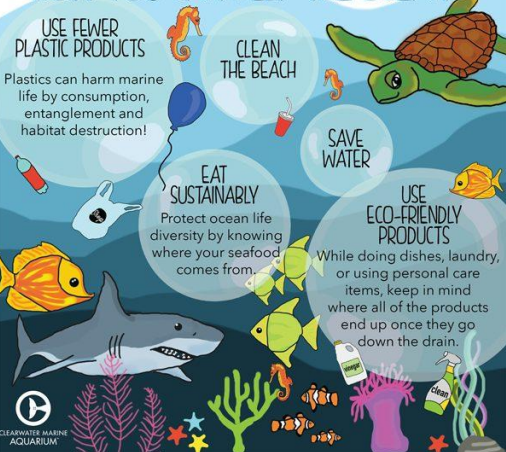
The oceans are under threat due to:

The Southern Ocean surrounds Antarctica and is the coldest ocean.

The Atlantic Ocean is the second largest ocean and covers 25% of the Earth.

Much of the Arctic ocean is covered with ice.
