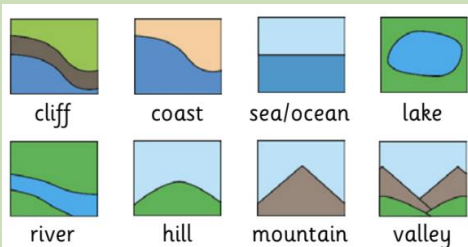

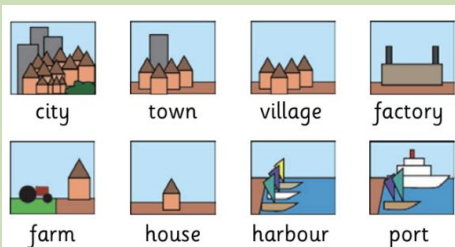
Physical Features

Physical features - things that occur naturally like seas, cliffs, hills and valleys.

Coastal areas are also known as shores and seashores. There are different types of coasts. They can be sandy or pebbled, flat or rocky.



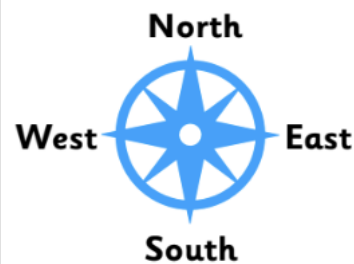
Brighton beach,

Key Vocabulary

Continent	A very large area of land with countries in them.
Ocean	A constant area of water that covers most (70%) of the earth's surface.
Sea	An area of salt water.
Coast	The land along a seas; where the land meets the water.
Country	An area of land with borders that is controlled by a single government.
Climate	The weather conditions in an area over a long period of time.
Atlas	A book or collection of maps that shows different regions of the world.
