Lovington Primary School recognises and values the importance of Physical Education and all physical exercise. Physical Education is an important part of our curriculum. It is inclusive and engages all pupils in a supportive environment. It is our intention to build a curriculum that enables children to develop knowledge, skills and vocabulary in a broad range of sporting activities, as well as developing values and transferrable life skills such as fairness and respect. In our school, we aim to deliver high-quality outdoor learning and play opportunities to ensure children attain optimum physical and emotional development and good health. Through this, we want to teach children how to cooperate and collaborate with others as part of an effective team, understanding fairness and equity of play to embed life-long values.

At Lovington C of E Primary School, we work hard to promote an active and healthy lifestyle through our taught curriculum, extra-curricular activities and participation in local sports festivals and intra school competitions. We aim to give opportunities for all pupils to develop their physical, leadership and coaching skills. As a school we want to create an environment where every child feels confident and ready to participate in all aspects of physical education.

Primary Sports Premium:

This financial year the school will receive £16, 370 to support and develop the delivery of high-quality PE in school. We have a school development plan that demonstrates how we intend to achieve this.

How we will use the money effectively:

With reference to funding, a large proportion has been allocated to staffing costs, where adults are used to teach during curriculum and extra curriculum time in order to inspire and challenge our children in their PE and sporting endeavours. This also includes the cost of specialist sports coaches to further enhance our children's experiences in PE. Where applicable, our PE leadership champions aspire to encourage effective CPD courses, as well as staff learning alongside established sports coaches as they teach our children. We also book staff onto external courses to upskill them in areas where audits have identified need. Additionally, we use money to enable our children to compete in inter school competition as we work towards our Bronze school games award. We also aim to recognise achievement in the form of trophies and medals for key competition and events.

Sustainability: We have ensured that PE is seamlessly woven into our curriculum with teachers continually developing confidence in delivering quality-first teaching in PE. This will be sustainable as we will continue to build on our current practices and ensure that each child has the opportunity to flourish in all areas of sport offered at Lovington C of E Primary School.
