Russet Class – Independence – Arthur

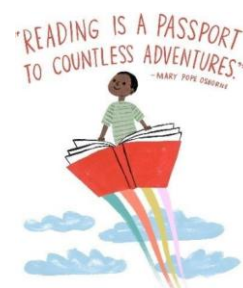
For trying really hard to give his work a try, before he asks an adult for help. Well done Arthur!
