This week, Pippin Class have been learning about the artist Jean-Michel Basquiat and his artwork. The children have discussed how it makes them feel, as well as thinking about how it was created and what artistic mediums were used. Our EYFS children have been learning about how to draw people, thinking about their own body proportions. We've got some fantastic artists in the making!

Years 3 and 4, have been experimenting with magnets to discover the materials that are magnetic. They decided that the results of their investigation suggest that metals are magnetic. Next week, they will be exploring whether this is true of all metals.

In science this week, Years 5 and 6 have been learning about the orbit of the different planets in our solar system. They also explored changing ideas about the shape of the Earth, including Aristotle's hypothesis that the Earth is spherical, proposed all the way back - around 340 BC.


