The children thoroughly enjoyed learning about the important roles our local police officers play in keeping our community safe. They were fascinated to explore the different pieces of equipment officers use and even had the exciting opportunity to hear a radio message!

Everyone loved going outside to see the police car up close and watch its lights in action. The children were eager to learn about the tools and resources officers carry in their vehicles and how they use them to help others.

A big thank you to our local officers for taking the time to visit and inspire our young learners.



On Wednesday, Key Stage Two took part in an online lesson with a terranaut for World Space Week. She told the children all about her career in STEM and how terranauts communicate and work with astronauts. They found out lots of interesting facts and were particularly keen to work out a way to travel to Jupiter when they were told that it rains diamonds there!

In English this week, Russet class have been working towards writing the ending to a story. They role played some key scenes and thought carefully about their characters and settings. They then created a story map with vivid vocabulary choices. They have some fantastic ideas and we can't wait to read the final outcomes!

Bramley Class have been exploring parallel and perpendicular lines, as well as right angles and symmetry. The children took their learning outdoors, investigating how these features appear in everyday life on the playground and in the wider school environment. This hands-on approach helped them to see the real-world applications of their classroom learning.
