Wells Festival of Literature Yr5/6 Event

Tuesday 21st October 2025

Dear Parents/Carers,

Organisers of the Wells Festival of Literature have invited our Year 5 and Year 6 children to hear the author, Sam Sedgman, talk about his life as an author and his new book *The Forbidden Atlas*.

This event will take place on **Tuesday 21st October**, at Cedars Hall, Wells. We will be travelling with the Year 6 children from Evercreech Primary School, departing at **8.45am** and getting back to school for a late lunch. We are very grateful to Wells Festival of Literature for fully funding the transport and the event.

The children will need to wear **school uniform** as usual on this day.

Your child will need a **packed lunch** to eat once back at school.

During the morning there will be an opportunity to meet the author and to buy signed copies of Sam Sedgman's books. There will be five titles for the children to choose from including the author's new book, *The Forbidden Atlas*. All the fiction books are available to buy at the much-reduced price of £2 (RRP £7.99) and the larger non-fiction at £3 and £5. The Literature Festival are only able to sell books at these prices by significantly subsidising the cost, for which we are very grateful.

The book titles and a description of the stories are below:

Both the above are exciting standalone adventures featuring aspiring inventor Isaac Turner.
