Key Vocabulary	
Decoration	A decoration is an item that you put on something else to make it look more attractive.
Fabric	Cloth such as cotton, silk and wool.
Template	Shape or pattern to use as a guide.
Running Stitch	A small even stitch run in and out of cloth.
Over Stitch	A stitch used to close edges together.
Decoration	Anything used to make something more attractive - buttons, sequins, ribbons etc.
Needle	A thin tool made of steel with a hole at one end and a sharp point at the other. You put the thread through the hole.
Seam	The sewing line where two pieces of fabric are joined - not too close to the edge!

## Types of Baubles

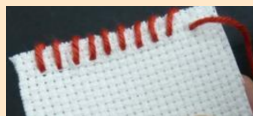


## Sewing Skills



### Running Stitch

A running stitch is when you run the needle and thread through the fabric.



### Over Stitch

An Over stitch is a different type of stitch which is good for sewing edges together.
